Dogmersfield Neighbourhood Development Plan Submission Consultation

Following consultation on the Pre Submission version of the Dogmersfield Neighbourhood Plan in November – December 2018 the Parish Council as the ‘qualifying body’ has amended the Plan and submitted it to Hart District Council.

Hart District Council is now required to carry out a further consultation on the Plan. The consultation period is between **Monday 11th February and 25th March 2019**, and all representations must be made to the District Council as set out below.

Following this six week public consultation, the proposed Plan will be submitted for independent examination. Dependent on the outcome of the examination the Plan will then be subject to a local referendum. If successful, the Dogmersfield Neighbourhood Plan will be ‘made’ (brought into legal force) and will form part of the Hart Development Plan and be used in the determination of planning applications relating to land in Dogmersfield Parish.
